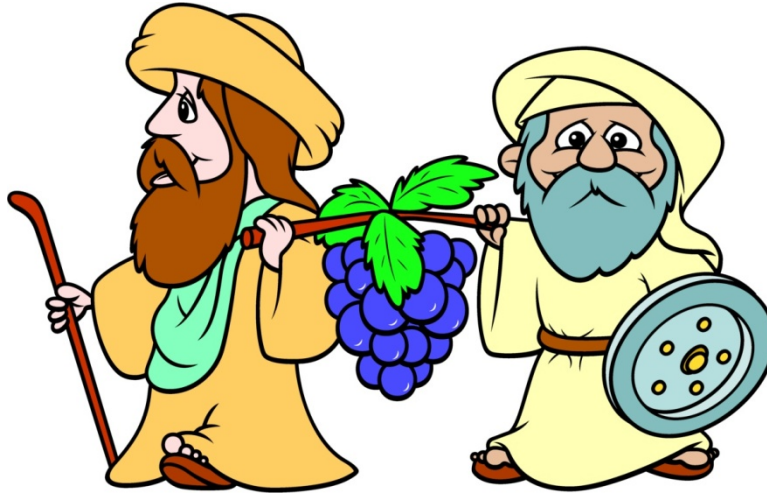

Through the Eyes of Isaiah



A prophet is a messenger of God, to tell of sins, failures and to describe what would happen if people did not repent and change their ways. Their intense focus and devotion to God led to amazing revelations and eloquent passages of scripture. Isaiah is one of the most beautifully written books in the Bible, including "The Song of the Vineyard": "The vineyard of the LORD Almighty is the nation of Israel, and the people of Judah are the vines he delighted in" Isaiah 5:7a

Objectives

By the end of the rotations, students will:

- Learn that Isaiah was prophet of God who lived long before Jesus was born but foretold his coming.
- Understand what it means to "be called by God".
- Think about "expectation" or "justice" from their personal experiences.
