



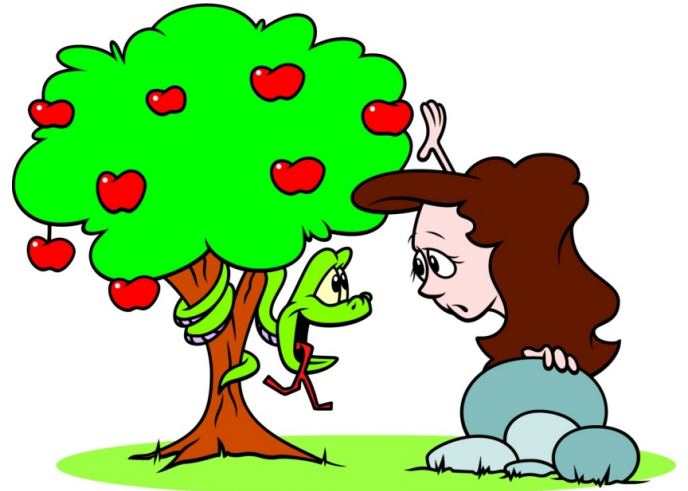

## The Fall of Adam and Eve

This isn't a story about the first two people and how they were made. This is a story about all people, and what we are all made of. This story is rigged. We know the moment God says, "Don't touch that tree" - we *will*. God knows it too - the moment he plants the tree.

This is a story not about "if" but about "why." It's about WHY and what happens WHEN we fall. And that means that Adam and Eve is the first story about redemption. The same God who knows what they've done still calls out to them in the Garden "Where are you?" even though He knows exactly where they are (God is God after all). God's call is a call of hope, an opportunity to come clean.



**Objectives:** By the end of this rotation, children will be able to:

- State in their own words some of the various conclusions or meanings of the story.
- Understanding the connection between Adam and Eve's sin and Jesus' death and resurrection.
- Identify temptations and wrong choices in their own lives, and ways to be obedient to God.
- Know that God has forgiven them even when they do wrong, and is our guide to doing right.
